Where should I stay?

Rates at the Omni Amelia Island Plantation Resort are \$249 per night for single/double occupancy. Prior to Monday, October 11, 2019, make hotel <u>reservations online</u> or by calling the hotel toll free at 904.261.6161 and mention CUES.

The hotel will accept reservations after October 11th based **on availability**; however, rooms may be gone before then, so early reservations are recommended. Staying within CUES' room block will help keep registration prices down.

A daily resort fee is included in the \$249/night rate. This includes:
