Utilize Pathway Deep Links

What is a Deep Link?

A deep link is a hyperlink that links to a specific piece of web content on a website, rather than the website's home page.

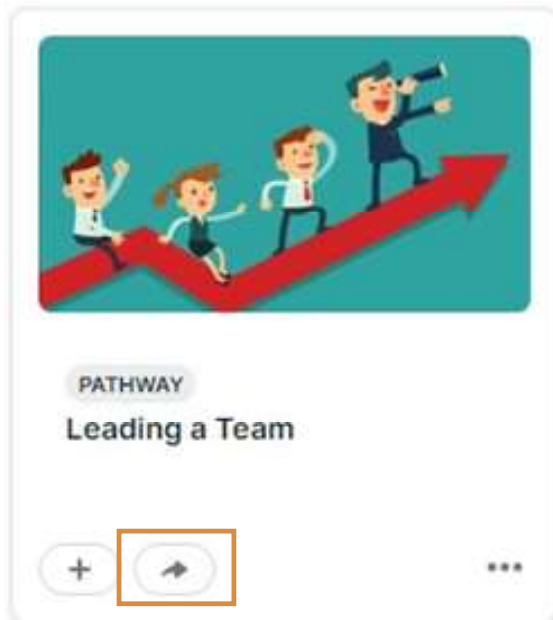
How Does a Deep Link Work?

In the CUES Learning Portal, using a deep link leverages the CUES single sign on with Degreed. This will direct the individual to the specific content/pathway, or the cues.org login page if the individual is not currently logged in.

Creating a Deep Link

You can create a deep link for a pathway or an individual piece of content.

- 1) Identify the content/pathway you'd like a deep link created for.
- 2) Click the "Share" button (arrow) to open the "Share this pathway" pop up.



- 3) Click the "Copy Link" button and paste the link as desired.



Using a Deep Link

Deep links can be used to share content via an email or can be added to your learning management system or intranet.

Paste a deep link into a task or assignment within your LMS. If desired, include a short quiz or reflection statement to support acknowledgement of completed content.

To gather data on any completions for a pathway, a report can be pulled for your credit union within CUES Learning Portal. See the "Create and Access Completion Reports" document for directions.
