The rate is good from Friday, August 16, 2024, through Friday, August 23, 2024, while availability exists within the block. If you are interested in coming early or staying longer, please call 800.548.4486 to check availability within or outside the CUES block.

Room rates and availability are not guaranteed, so CUES recommends making your reservations early. The discounted CUES rate will expire when the block is full or on Tuesday, July 16, 2024, whichever happens first. A credit card is required to guarantee your reservation. A one-night room & tax deposit will be due at the time of booking.
