

How to add the Bookmarklet to your Web Browser Toolbar

The bookmarklet feature is only available to CUES members through CUES Learning Tracker. The bookmarklet button that you will add to your web browser toolbar will work with Internet Explorer 10, Chrome, Safari and Firefox only. This feature will not work on mobile devices or older web browsers.

- 1) Upon logging into www.cues.org you can click on the Learning Tracker button in the top right hand corner.

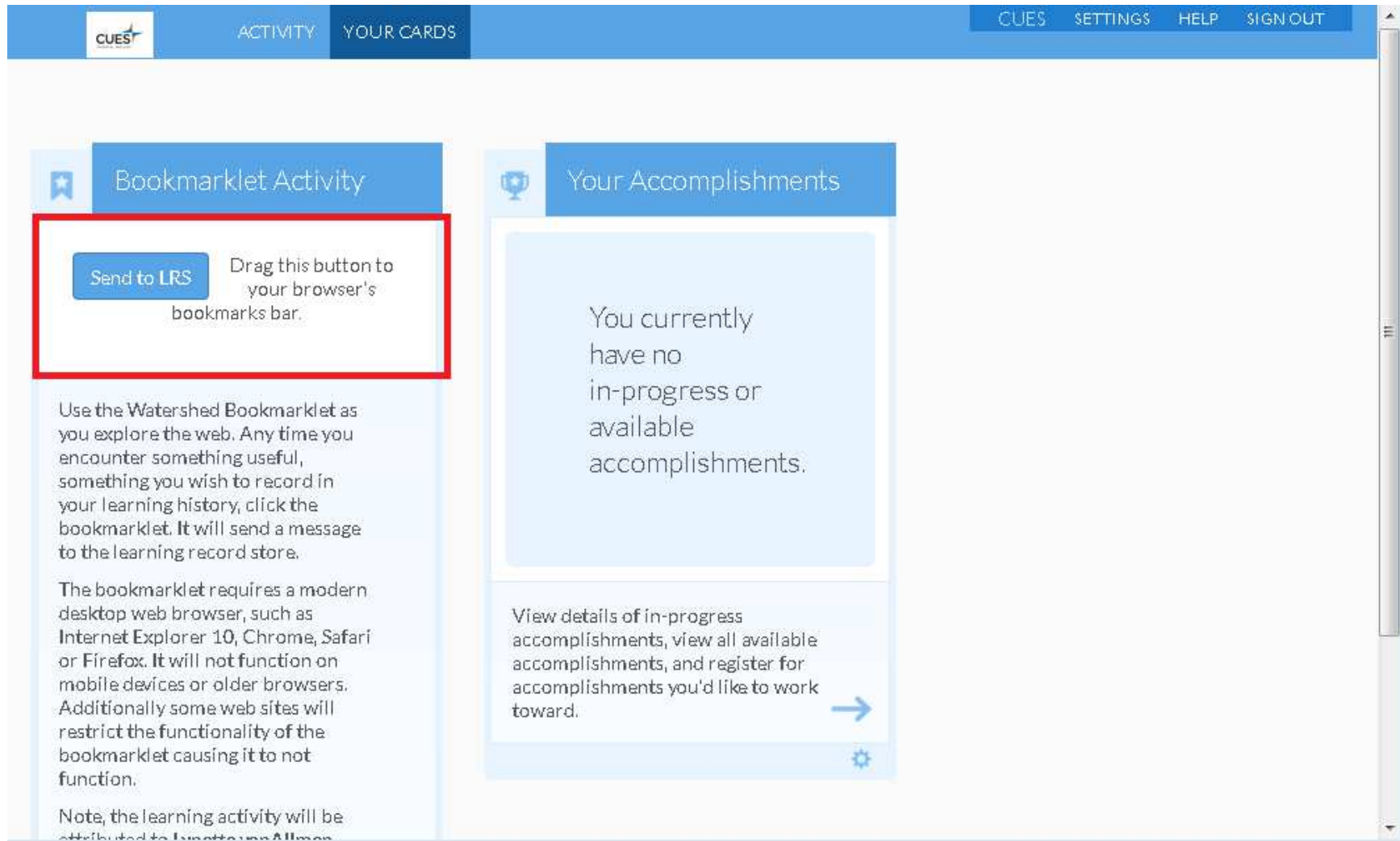
2) This will open up a new tab in your browser and seamlessly log you into CUES Learning Tracker, where you will see the following screen, you will look above to the tool bar and click on "Your Cards."

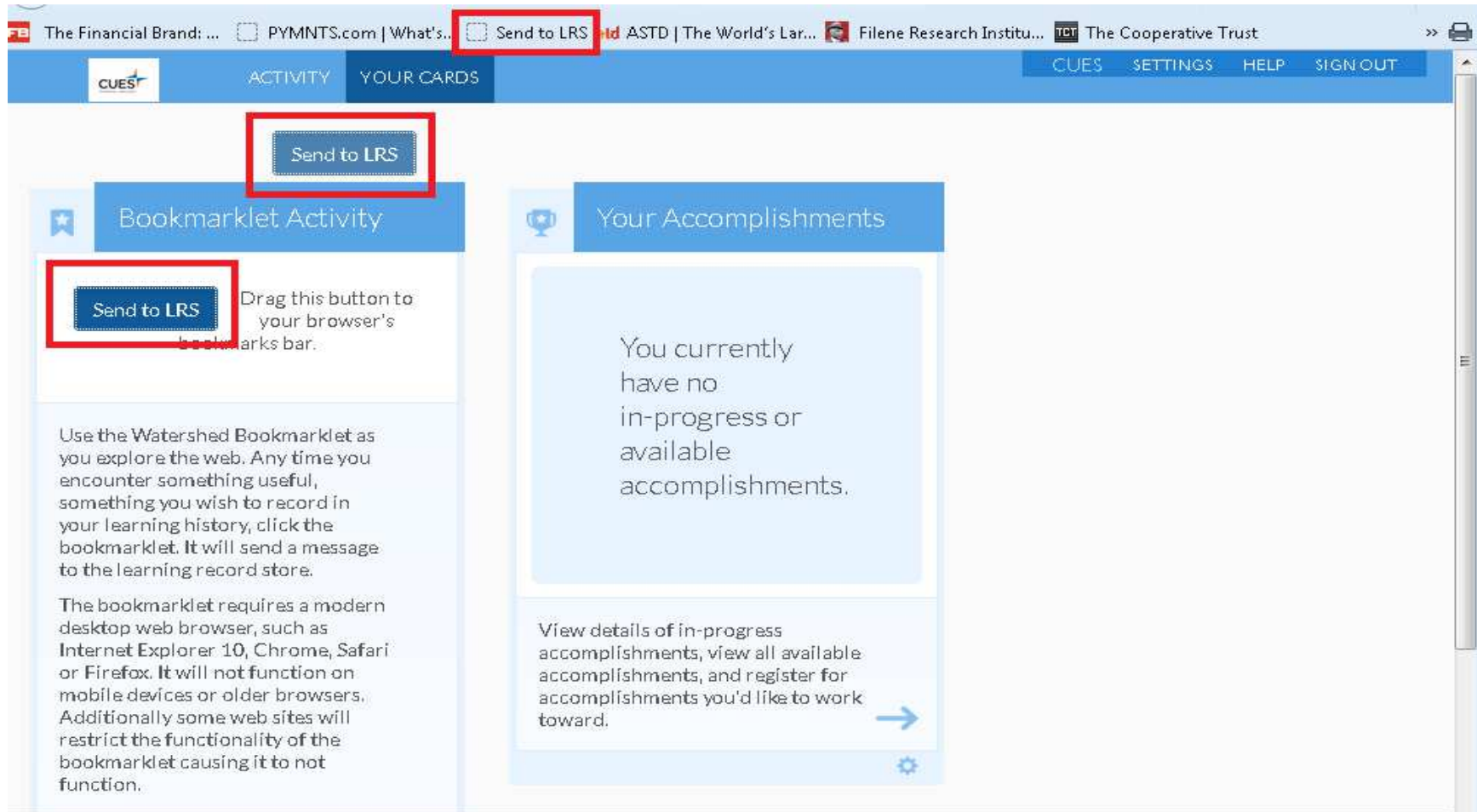

3) You will now see a box titled "Bookmarklet Activity," a button and instructions to drag that button to your toolbar.



- 4) You will click and hold on the "Send to LRS" button and drag it up to your toolbar, below where the web address bar is located:



You will then be able to navigate to most websites and click on that button and your activity will be tracked. Some web sites will restrict the functionality of the bookmarklet causing it to not function.
